

24 Hour GRAB Bag List

This backpack is your "grab and go" gear ready at all times.

Bring this gear with you for call outs to base camp, as part of a field response team, when setting up a shelter and at trainings & exercises.

Backpack with padded shoulder straps and hip belt
Put your name on all your gear!

Required for all Call Outs

ID Badges - WASART, Emergency Worker, Medical Conditions/Contact cardID
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Lanyard

Response Clothing - if you do not have logo gear yet, bring plain clothing without advertising

Bandana - has multiple uses
BDU Cargo type pants/belt - long pants are required in the field and around animals
Gloves - leather, gripper, latex type
Logo Ball Cap/Hat
Logo Rain jacket
Logo Shirt
Logo Sweatshirt
Logo Vest or Soft shell jacket
Rain Pants
Sturdy Boots/Heavy Socks

Duct tape

Emergency "Space" Blanket/Bag
Energy Bars Dried Fruit, Nut mix or similar food sources for 24 hours
Eye Safety Glasses/Goggles
First Aid Kit for personal use
Flashlight, extra batteries, spare bulb holder for belt
FRS "2 way" Radio, batteries
Glow stick
Ham Radio, extra battery pack, must be licensed to use
Headlamp and batteries
Knife - sheath or folding
Multi tool
Pen/Pencil/Marker/Highlighter
Reflective Safety Vest
Rite in Rain Notebook - pocket size
WASART Business Cards good for networking and follow up.
Water bottles or camelback (at least 2 quarts)
Water filter or purifying tablets
Whistle
